



## WIC Breastfeeding Peer Counselor

Responsibilities include: attend breastfeeding training classes to become a peer counselor; receive a caseload of WIC clients and make routine periodic contacts with all clients assigned; provide follow through with each client; provide basic breastfeeding information and support to new mothers, including informing them about the benefits of breastfeeding, overcoming common barriers, and getting a good start with breastfeeding. This is a part-time position.

Qualifications include:

- High School Diploma or equivalent required.
- Previous experience breastfeeding at least one baby (does not have to be currently breastfeeding).
- Is enthusiastic about breastfeeding, and wants to help other mothers enjoy a positive experience.
- Has a telephone and is willing to make phone calls from home beyond the WIC clinic hours.
- Has reliable transportation and holds a valid driver's license.
- Excellent customer service, organizational, interpersonal, written and oral communication skills.
- Sensitivity to the needs of the participant population.
- Ability to maintain accurate records and maintain confidentiality of information.
- Proficient computer skills required in basic computer software and data collection systems.
- Ability to remain calm and exercise judgment in unusual or stressful situations.
- Bilingual skills (English/Spanish) preferred.
