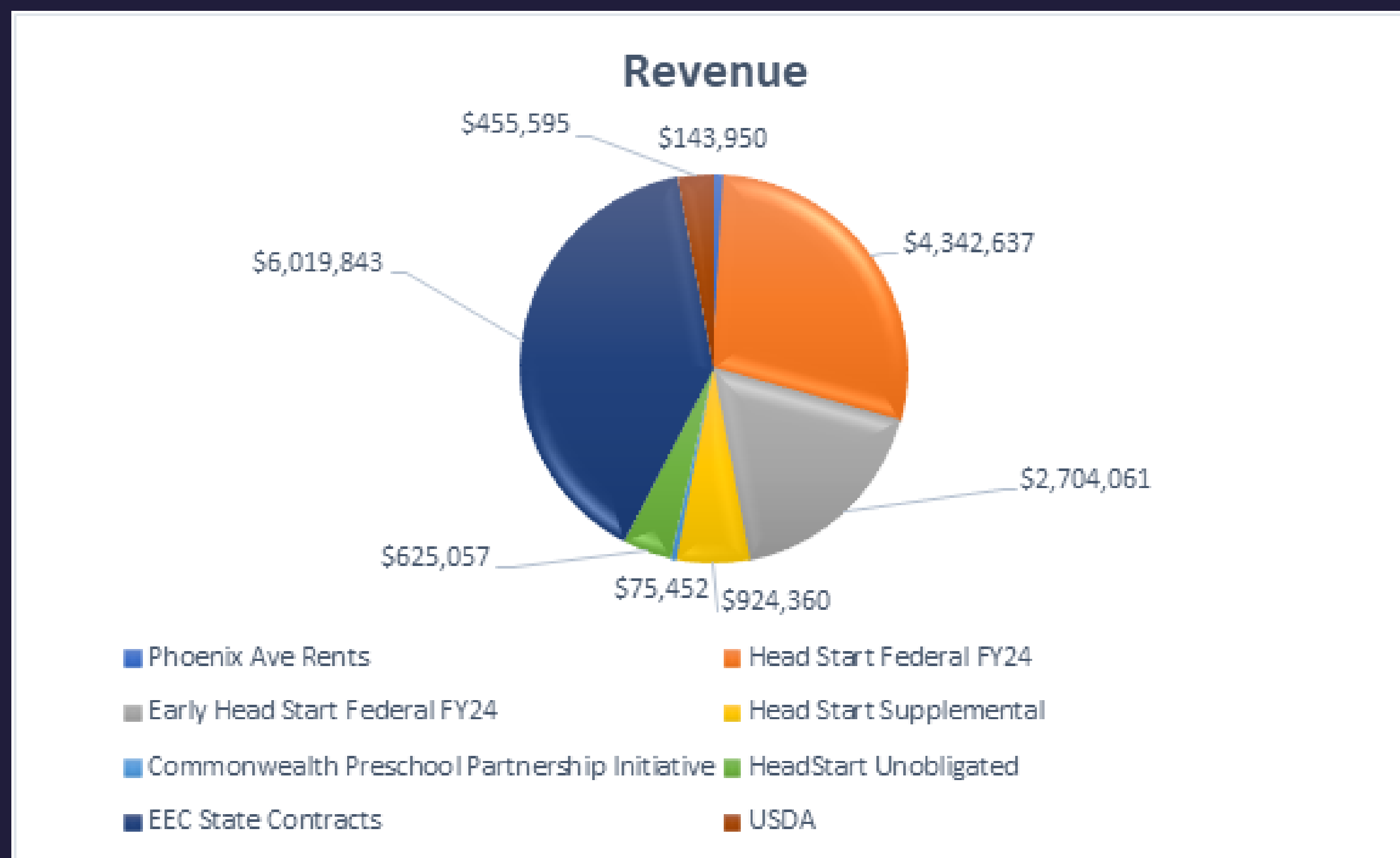

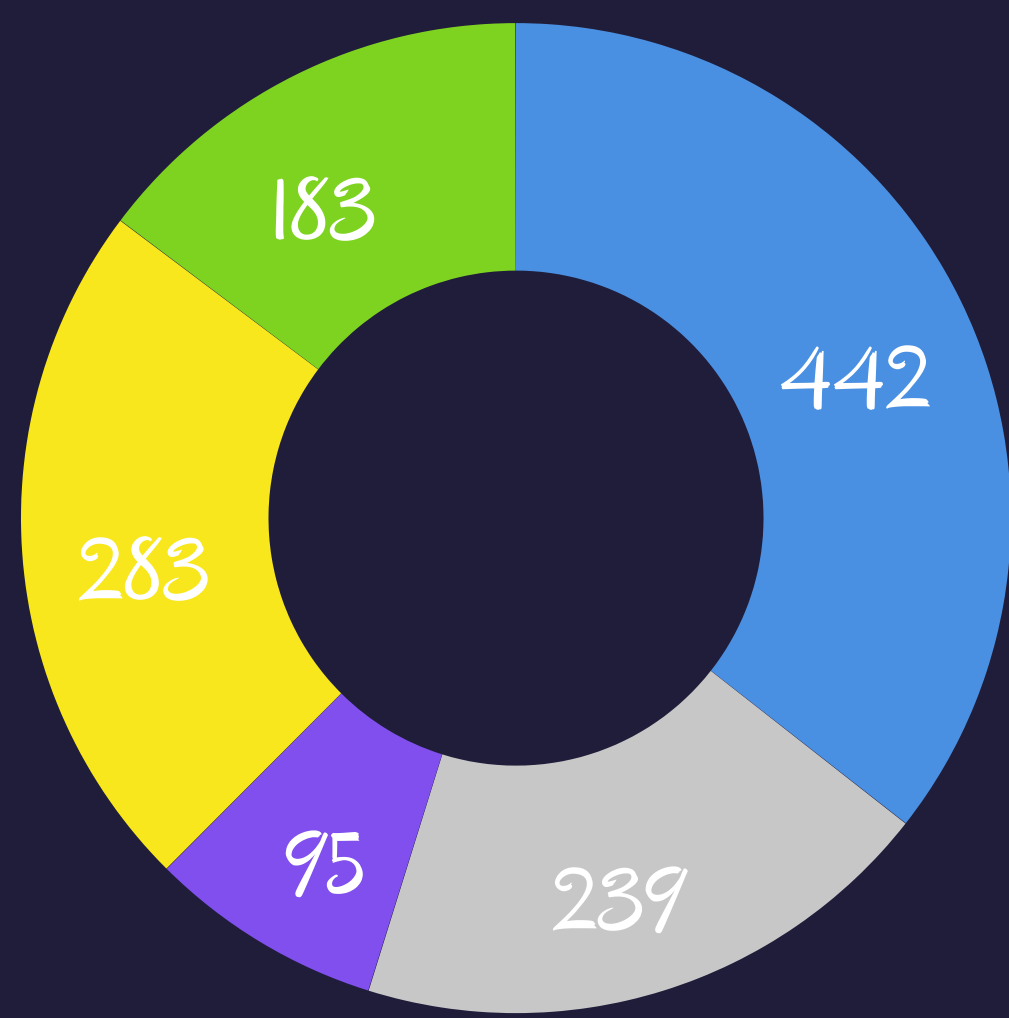

Family Engagement

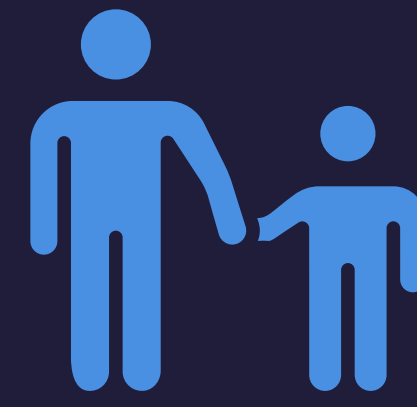
Services Provided to Families
